RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 One Art submission per person.
- 2 All media are eligible, including drawing, painting, photography, original prints, fine craft, mixed media and sculpture.
- 3 All Entries must have a completed entry form (included in brochure) attached to the back of your artwork.
- 4 The theme for this year's art competition will be "Who is Your Grimsby?". To be eligible to win, submissions must focus on Grimsby Personalities and their contributions to Grimsby.
- 5 The Competition is open to all Grimsby residents and anyone affiliated with Grimsby Schools, clubs, churches, and organizations.
- 6 There will be 6 Category Levels:
 - 1) Junior & Senior Kindergarten
 - 2) Primary Students: Grades 1, 2 & 3
 - 3) Junior Students: Grades 4, 5 & 6
 - 4) Senior Students: Grades 7 & 8
 - 5) High School Students: All Grades
 - 6) Adults

- 1 **Deadline for Entries:**
Friday February 9, 2018 by 5:00 pm.
Artwork must be delivered to the Grimsby Public Art Gallery between Feb. 5 -9 during regular Gallery hours. Artwork can be picked up at the participating Schools' main office if requested.
- 2 **Award Celebration: Sunday February 18, 2018**
All entrants and the general public are welcome to attend the Award Celebration at the Grimsby Public Art Gallery at 1:30 pm. The winning art work will be on display at the GPAG during Heritage Week (Feb. 18-25) and the exhibit will continue to March 18th. Winning Entrants will be presented with Certificates at a Town Council Meeting. Winning artwork may also be displayed again at other town events.
- 3 **Cash Prizes:**
1st prize: \$75
2nd Prize: \$50
3rd Prize \$25
Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners in each of the 6 Category Levels at Grimsby Council with their Certificates (date to be determined).

- 4 **Artwork return: Plan ahead!**
On Friday, February 16th *All submitted Artwork, excluding winners, must be picked up at the Art Gallery .
Between Monday March 19 - Wednesday March 21 during regular gallery hours, all winning artwork must be picked up at the Art Gallery. Due to limited storage space, any artwork not picked up by this date will no longer be available, so please make sure you plan to retrieve your artwork.
