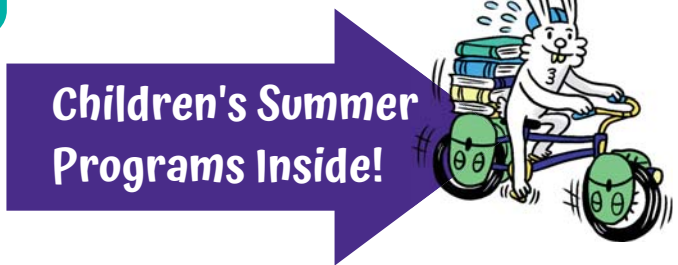
## Teen Reading Challenge

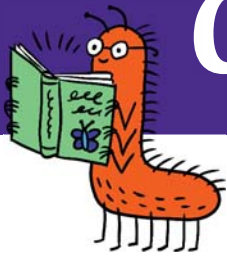
